Sir/Madam,

In continuation of this office Circular No.DE-156-(Act&Reg-NAAC)-2020/1532 dated 24.08.2020 (copy enclosed), I am again directed to invite your kind attention to the relevant extract of Dental Council of India (Miscellaneous) Regulations, 2007, which states as follows:-

- "9. Accreditation of Dental Institutions in the country by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) is mandatory."
- 2. In this connection, I am directed to say that even after repeated directions of this Council, most of the Dental Colleges have not yet furnished a certified copy of the Accreditation Certificate issued by NAAC, to this council and this Council has taken a serious view in the mater, therefore, they are hereby directed to furnish a certified copy of the Accreditation certificate issued by NAAC, to this Council, at the earliest.
- 3. Kindly ignore, if your dental college has already furnished a certified copy of the Accreditation certificate issued by NAAC.
- 4. This issues with the prior approval of the Competent Authority.
